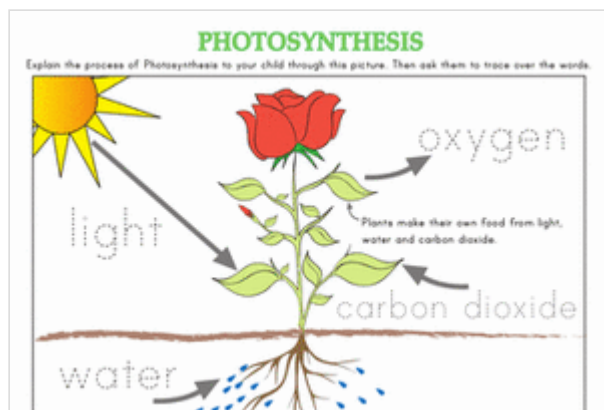


Worksheet: How Plants Grow

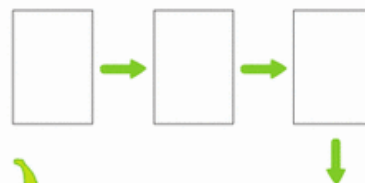
